

Access to research infrastructures

Europe's leading centres for systematics-related research invite scientists based at European institutes to access their collections, facilities and libraries with the support and training from in-house researchers and curators.

Through the support of the European Community – Research Infrastructure activity under the FP6 'Structuring the European Research Area' Programme access is being offered under the project SYNTHESYS to the following eleven national Taxonomic Facilities (TAFs).
